

4 Creative Ways to Decorate Your Walls at Home in 2020

Take the phrase home improvement to heart in 2020 with these stylish and functional wall ideas that will refresh the home.

From chic colour blocking ideas to a plant feature wall, Rebecca Snowden, Interior Style Advisor at <u>FurnitureChoice.co.uk</u>, shares 4 on-trend DIY ideas just in time for spring.

1. Half-painted colour block walls

Start the new year on a stylish note by introducing a half-painted wall to the home. As a trend that's expected to continue its popularity in 2020, half-painted walls are a chance to make a statement with colour without being overwhelmed by it.

Begin this simple DIY project by choosing a colour with a deep undertone such as Pantone's Colour of the Year Classic Blue or sage green and pair it with a light neutral like cream or white for maximum impact. Attention to detail is key here - prep the walls with primer and use frog tape to create a line on the wall. "On first impression, half-painted walls generate a modern and striking effect to the room," Rebecca comments. "Opt for the lines to take up two-thirds of the



wall to create a colourful juxtaposition between the backdrop and the centrepiece of the room, whether that's the sofa or bed."

2. Panelled walls with wooden plant shelf



Inject warmth and texture to the home office with wooden wall panels which add personality to the room without being overly dramatic. Take advantage of these features by installing a wooden plant shelf using reclaimed wood.

"A wooden plant shelf is a stylish way to display greenery in your home while adding your own personal touch," Rebecca says. "For this DIY, it's important to measure how far up the walls the shelf will be placed to ensure that your plants get enough sunlight. In line with the foliage theme, choose a forest green colour palette as it provides an optimistic boost amidst the warm wood tones of a writing desk."

3. Ombre feature wall

Introducing an ombre feature wall adds an artistic watercolour effect in the bedroom. Offering a subtle option to bold colour-blocked walls, the ombre effect comes to life by blending blue and green together to create teal - a deep jewel tone that establishes a cosy space meant for relaxation.

"The ombre look has continued to mesmerise the design world with its ability to transform any space," Rebecca says. "When planning, determine the direction of your colour flow such as from light at the bottom to dark at the top, or vice versa. A teal ombre feature wall creates a laid back, tropical look in the bedroom so make sure that the wall next to it complements these qualities. Choose emerald for its calming qualities, blending in with the soft textured fabrics and dark wooden tones."

4. Staghorn Fern display wall

Decorating with indoor plants on the walls is a creative way to display greenery at home while giving the space a unique twist. With that in mind, opt for a staghorn fern display wall in the living room or kitchen for a raw, natural feel.

With the help of Zosia Berkieta-Lewis from The Plant Room, this 10-step DIY project requires a lot of preparation so it's best to get the tools ready before starting, such as a hammer, nails and wooden boards. "Adapt the staghorn fern display wall to fit the size of your walls by selecting how many boards you want to put up," Rebecca advises. "With everything in place, the warm wood tones of the boards create a natural focal point in the living room or kitchen while the plants purify the air."
