

— How to make marbled Christmas baubles

Bring a luxe touch to your décor this festive season.

Rebecca Snowden, Interior Style Advisor at Furniture And Choice ([FurnitureChoice.co.uk](https://www.furniturechoice.co.uk)), shares 4 steps to creating marbled baubles for Christmas.

1. Prepare the items



Items needed:

- Plain white baubles
- 2 cans of metallic spray paint (in different colours)
- Ribbon
- Paint tray
- Wooden stick
- Drying rack

2. Prep the spray paint



Start by pouring water onto the tray. Next, shake the spray paint cans. Then spray a bit of each paint onto the tray.



3. Create a marbled effect



Use the wooden stick to stir the paint around the tray. This will create a marbled effect.



Next, hold the bauble at its tip and then gently move it in a clockwise motion around the tray. Do this until the bauble surface is completely covered in paint.

4. Add the final touches



Leave the baubles to dry. Once done, thread the ribbon through the hoop.



Use the bauble as part of a festive table setting or as a tree ornament.
